- <u>IREAD-3 Scores</u>- Official IREAD-3 scores were published via the IDOE, and WES (and NL) were in some elite territory.
 - O John Glenn School Corporation (WES and NL combined) finished tied for 31st in the state out of 364 school corporations with a 94.3% pass rate, putting JGSC in the 93rd percentile in Indiana (meaning we performed better than 93% of all school corporations in Indiana). If we look at PUBLIC schools only, JGSC finished tied for 22nd in the state!
 - o Individually, WES finished 127th out of 1,021 individual public elementary schools in Indiana, putting WES in the 93rd percentile. North Liberty finished 147th out of 1,021 individual public elementary schools, putting NLES in the 92nd percentile.


