North Central CTE Student Spotlight

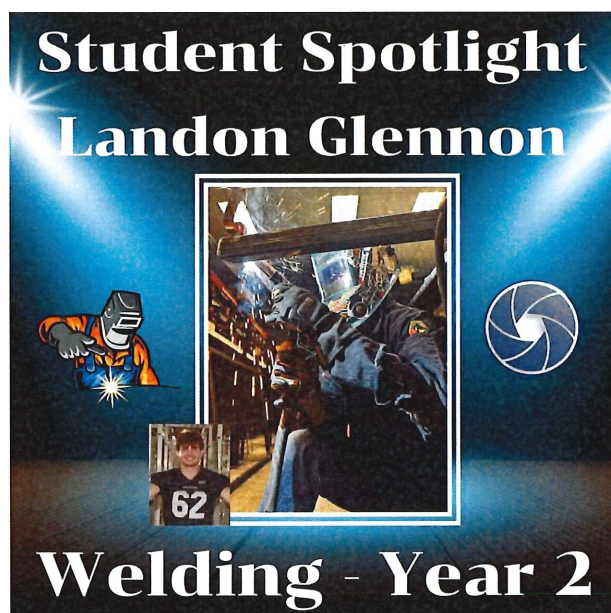
