The John Glenn High School Spell Bowl Team earned Runner-Up (second place) at the State Spell Bowl Finals in the Class 2 division on November 10. This is the first time the team returned to the state level since 2016. At the state competition, Van Foresman and Olivia Kalicki earned perfect scores, and Samuel Thomas earned a near perfect. At the regional competition on November 2nd, Van Foresman earned a perfect score, and Samuel Thomas and Olivia Kalicki earned near perfect scores. This was the first year the competition was held virtually throughout the state. Each school competed either at their own school, or virtually from student's homes. The IASP also offered something new to students who earned a perfect score at the regional competition: to compete individually against other perfect spellers across the state at the state competition. Van Foresman was able to compete individually and spelled 88 out of 90 words correctly, tying for 3rd place in the individual competition.
