OPEN HOUSE - Aug. 7

Come to school with your school supplies and meet your teacher August 7 from 5:30 -7:00 PM. The office ladies will be available to collect documents and lunch payments. State legislation has removed textbook fees to parents - **No Book Fees this year!**

1st DAY OF SCHOOL - Aug. 9

Please be patient with the first day of school as families take pictures on the lawn and other safe areas. Out of safety and protection of all, we require parents to release their child at the front door where they will then walk to the main gym. We will hold a short "Welcome" assembly and then escort students to their classrooms.

MORNING PROCEDURES:

7:40 - Students enter the foyer area.
7:45 - Breakfast is available.
7:45 - Students dismissed for class. The goal is to have students in the building by 8:00 AM.
8:05 Tardy bell, parents must sign their child in at the office.

HOMEROOM TEACHERS: Teachers have been assigned in Harmony and class lists will be posted at Open House on August 7, 2023.

ATTENDANCE

Being at school on time and on a regular basis is one of the single greatest influences on a student's ability to succeed in school. In the event that your child is sick, please contact the office 574-656-8123 prior to 8:30 AM to inform us of the reason for absence. If your child is absent and no call is made, Schoolreach will be contacting the phone number listed in Harmony to make you aware.

The Department of Education is increasing accountability on school attendance. As a school, our goal is to decrease absenteeism with our overall percentage and individual students that had chronic absences last year. Mrs. Bogard and Mr. Romer will meet with students and parents who are considered "chronically absent" to work to support families and decrease absenteeism.

BUS TRANSPORTATION AND CHANGES

Be patient the first couple days with bus pick up and drop off times. Drivers will be contacting you by Monday evening on possible times. The routes are determined by the registration information in Harmony. We are requiring one location for drop off and pick up to streamline the process. If you didn't completely fill out the transportation form when registering, please call the office to advise us of your updates.

Pick up procedures: You may park in the north parking lot (best for older students) where students can walk to that location and meet you on the lawn. **If you are in line alongside the sidewalk, stay in your vehicle and your student will walk to you.** If you are parking, please walk to the lawn and meet your child. Please stay off the long sidewalk area where students line up and wait for you.
