 - Later this month, WES will participate in the Elementary Science Bowl Competition through the state: This team is the first Science Bowl Team in WES history

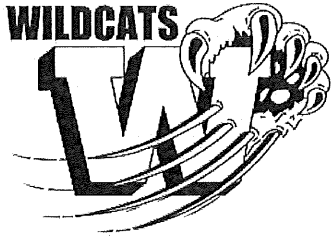

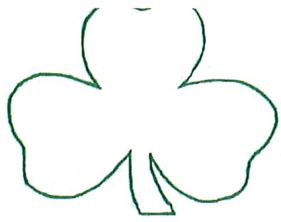

Students are learning mindfulness skills in the classroom. Each week, they learn a new skill and practice the skill each period before class starts.



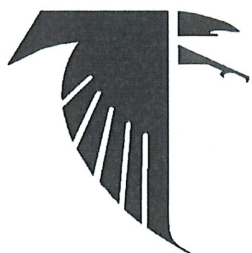
Students in Mr. Groves' Life Fitness class are working on getting in shape!
