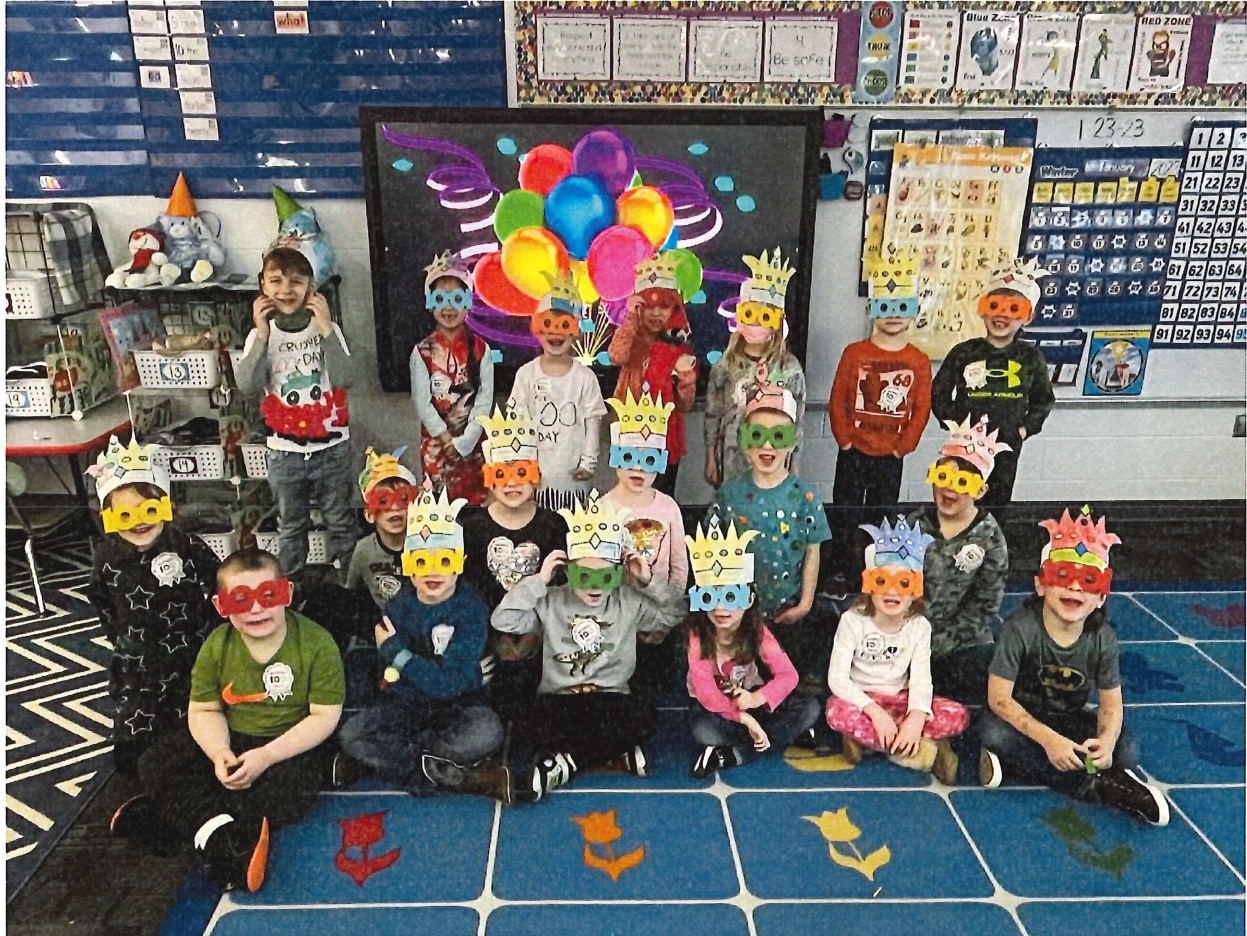

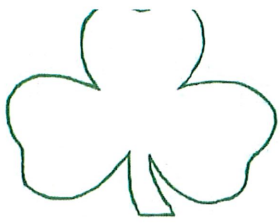

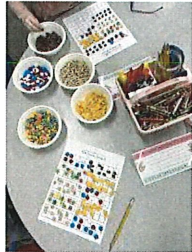
## North Liberty Board Donation and Recognitions for January 24, 2023

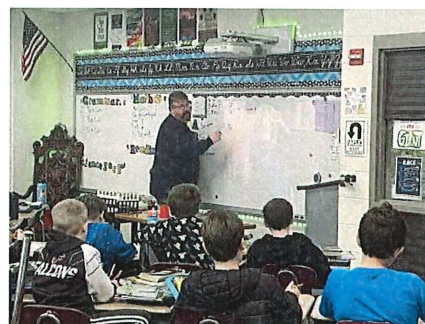

Abigail Lianez: Honorable Mention Poetry

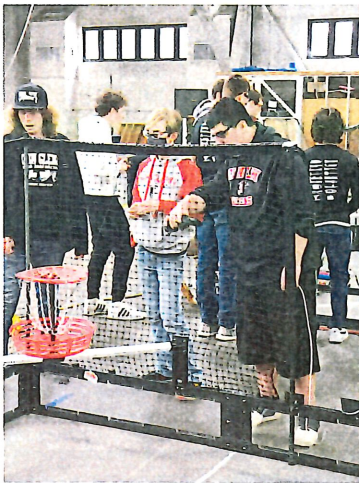
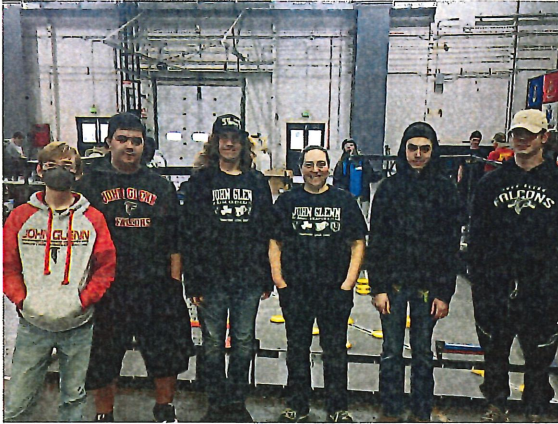
