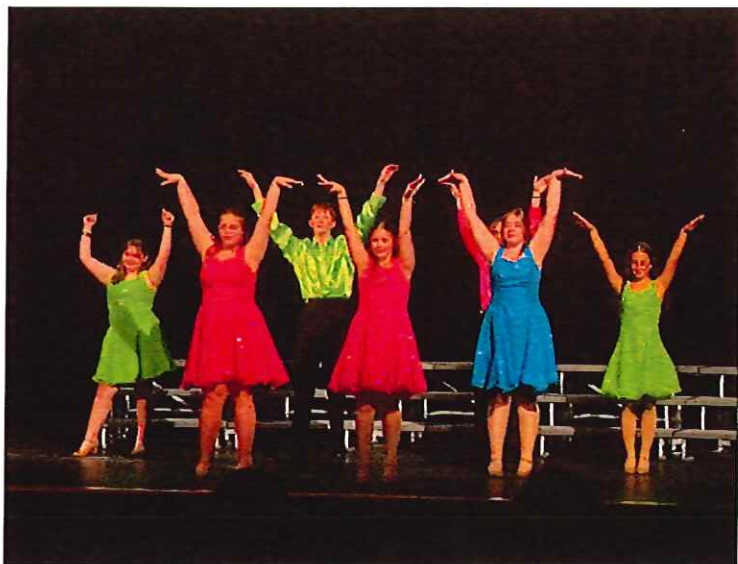
#### **FFA**
