OFFICE REMINDERS:

Absences: Being at school is one of the single greatest influences on a student's ability to succeed in school. In the event that your child is sick, please contact the office 574-656-8123 prior to 8:30 AM with reason of illness or scheduled appointments. Doctor excuse notes are required with any appointment for proper documentation.

<u>Transportation Changes</u>: Need written note with name of person picking up by car. If calling, notify the office before 2:00 PM. A weekly plan is encouraged in place of daily changes that may cause confusion with students.

Entering School: We line up KDG-3rd Grade students in the building to help with overcrowding on the sidewalk at 7:35. Breakfast is available as early as 7:35. Students leave for their classrooms at 7:50. The goal is to have students in the building by 8:00 AM. Any time after 8:05 is considered tardy and parents must sign their child in at the office.

AM & PM Car RIDERS

The pace of drop off depends on everyone following procedures. We ask that <u>you pull ahead</u> <u>as far as possible</u> in the drop off zone. Have your child(ren) exit the right side of the vehicle and walk along the sidewalk to the entrance. If you wish to walk your child to the door, park in a diagonal parking spot and walk your child to the sidewalk. This means no parking along the drop off lane by the sidewalk.
