Prom

We have been working with the local health departments and have been given their blessing to have prom on April 30th. The location for prom has been switched to Swan Lake this year. We have not finalized all the details, but the following guidelines are extremely important from the health departments:

- COVID Restrictions will be required. More specific protocols to come from the health department.
- There will be guest restrictions for non JGHS students.
- A permission slip will be required to be signed by the parent in order for the student to attend.

Students will be receiving additional communication from the Junior Class Sponsors in regards to ticket prices, times for prom, when tickets will go on sale, etc. We also plan to continue our tradition in recent years to allow prom attendees to leave early on Friday in order to get ready.

Graduation

We are still finalizing the details, but we are anticipating having an outdoor graduation over the weekend where graduation is scheduled. We will be having graduation outdoors on Friday May 28th at 7:00 PM on the Football Field. A rain date of Sunday May 30th at 2:00 PM will also be anticipated. If we have inclement weather on both days, we will utilize the gymnasium for a make-up date on Sunday May 30th at 2:00 PM with limited tickets for graduates. We plan to

utilize the outdoor venue in order to have more people to be in attendance. More details to come in the near future.
