Students have been notified of the expectations for these days and we wanted to let you know the details and expectations for e-learning on 11/23 and 11/24. The e-learning days will not have live instruction on 11/23 and 11/24. Students will be getting their assignments from their teachers and those assignments will be posted on Canvas. Here is a bulleted list of important information regarding e-learning on 11/23 and 11/24:

- Monday 11/23 will be a Falcon Day (Periods 5-8). The administration will be sending an email to all students for the 8th period for this day. (Look for an email from Mr. Manering)
- Tuesday 11/24 will be a Black/Red/White Day (Periods 1-4)
- All work assigned on 11/23 will be due Monday, 11/30, and all work assigned on 11/24 will be due on Tuesday, 12/1. Attendance will be taken based on the completion of assignments on 11/30 and 12/1.
- Assignments will be posted on Canvas well before 11/23 and 11/24. We want to allow students the opportunity to complete any assignments prior to the two e-learning days. On Thursday, 11/19, any hard copies and assignments can be given to the students for period 5-8, and Friday 11/20 any hard copies and assignments can be given to students for periods 1-4.
- Teachers will be available from 9:00 AM-2:00 PM each of these days to answer questions.
